



Biology Teacher

We are seeking a hardworking and enthusiastic teacher to join a team of subject specialists.

The ability to work in a team is essential as the Science department has 20 teachers supported by 3 laboratory technicians

A willingness to contribute to courses at Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 is essential. A suitable candidate may also have the opportunity to teach on the A Level course.

At Key Stage 3, the students follow a modular framework with members of the team taking responsibility for preparing and managing a number of modules. There is no set text at Key Stage 3, although material from Badger Science and Exploring Science has been used in writing the course. In Key Stage 4, we are working with the Examination Board, AQA, and students follow GCSE courses in Science and Additional Science or Biology, Chemistry & Physics. In the Sixth Form, we offer A Levels in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Psychology, Health & Social Care and Applied Science.

The Science Department has 9 well equipped laboratories, 3 preparation rooms, 2 study rooms and access to computer resources areas.

Thomas Telford School has an excellent reputation for achieving excellent results. In 2011, 89% of all Year 8 students achieved a level 6 in Science at the End of Key Stage 3. In addition, 99% of all Year 11 students achieved at least two GCSEs in Science (grades A*-C)
